## **KCH Creates Jazz Club Feel with Kerrytown Club Series**

*Paul Keller Trio and Bolcom & Morris open new series*

September 2, 2010 — Ann Arbor, Mich. — Kerrytown Concert House is pleased to announce the launch of the Kerrytown Club series, a new monthly series that serves up jazz and cabaret in an intimate nightclub setting. To set the mood, café tables will often take the place of the first two rows in the hall and a cash bar will be available. KCH expects to present two Kerrytown Club series events per month. The Kerrytown Club series is sponsored in part by the Southeastern Michigan Jazz Association.

The Firefly Club, a much-loved venue in Ann Arbor's jazz community, closed its doors last year. KCH has always presented a jazz in-concert series, but with the sad closing of the Firefly Club, it will be opening its doors more frequently to area and national artists who had made the Firefly their home.

The **Paul Keller Trio** will kick off the series with a tribute to the Nat "King" Cole Trio on **Friday, October 8 at 8 p.m.** This area all-star ensemble, which includes Ralph Tope (guitar) and Steve Richko (piano), celebrates the release of their CD "We Like To Riff: A Toast to The Nat King Cole Trio." The following evening, the internationally renowned husband-and-wife duo of composer-pianist **William Bolcom** and mezzo-soprano **Joan Morris** perform Bolcom's cabaret songs plus a range of classics and obscure gems spanning the history of American popular song. They perform two sets on **Saturday, October 9 at 7 and 9 p.m.**

Tickets for the Paul Keller Trio are \$30 for café tables up front, \$20 for rows 3-5, and \$15 for general admission. Tickets for Bolcom and Morris are \$35 for seats in rows 1-2, \$25 for rows 3-5, \$15 for general admission and \$10 for students.
